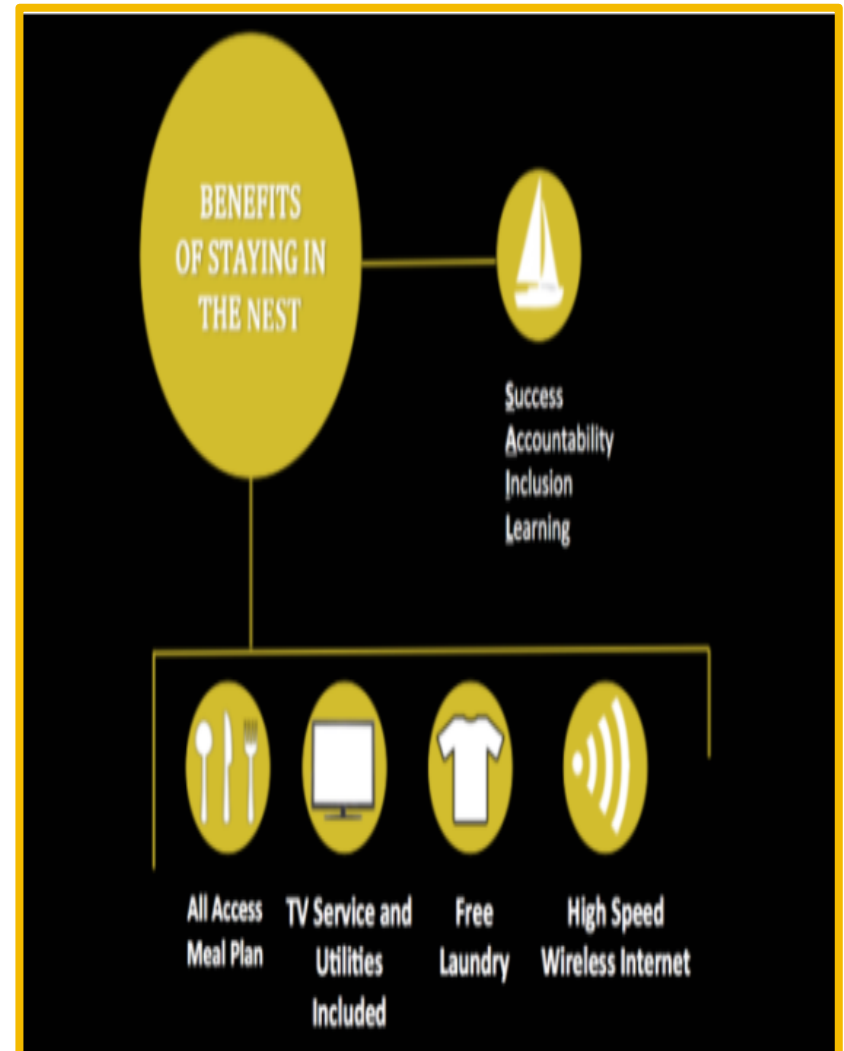

What is Room Selection?

- The housing lottery is a structured process to ensure returning students are placed in on-campus housing in the most objective way possible.
- The process will happen from 6pm-9pm on April 13 and 14, 2015.
- OURES deems the housing lottery process as the most effective, efficient, fair, and flexible way to allow students to choose their own rooms.

Priority Number

- For each room selection process random numbers are issued to determine the assignment of a selection date and time.
- Random numbers are generated in excel for eligible students with completed online applications for each process
- Numbers are assigned by class standing, application submission by priority deadline, and host preference.
- 15 minute time slots for each selection time

Room Selection Information

- You will receive your priority number and time via your OU email, which will be sent to you on the week of March 2-6, 2015.
- You **MUST** bring your priority number email (in print or electronic) with you to room selection and your Petrel Pass!



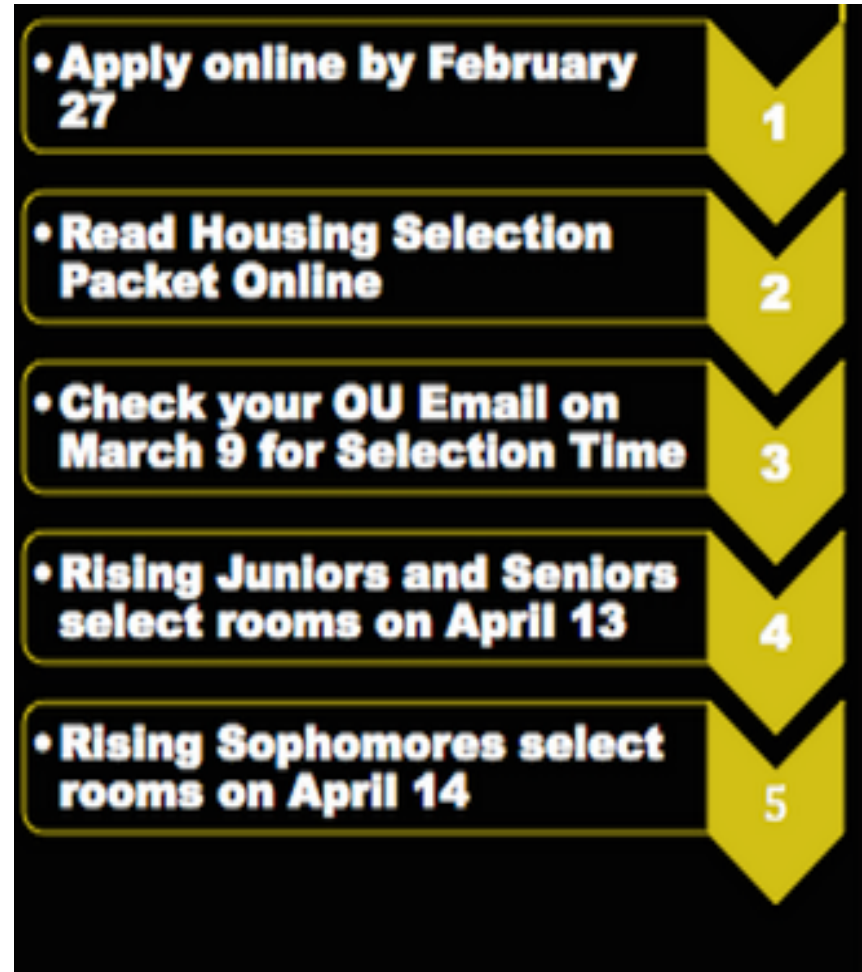
Gables Residential

- Residential Requirement for First, Second, and Third Year Students
- Gables Residential will be an option for upperclass students to be exempt from the OURES housing policy
- Gables Residential is a private company with their own unit reservation and leasing process.
- Buildings are scheduled to open in January 2016.



The Process

- TLCC Trustee Room
- Appropriate line for time
- Approach OURES staff when your turn and share preferences
- You will sign up for housing after sharing preferences
- You will receive a selection card with housing assignment
- Hand your selection card to an RA on your way out.



Room Selection Notes

- You may arrive as early as you would like, but you will **NOT** be able to select a room before your assigned time.
- Bring the following:
 - Email with priority number (print/electronic)
 - Petrel Pass
 - Proxy Form (if applicable)
 - NOTE: You **CANNOT** select a room without these items.
- While in line, keep eye on floor plans being marked to see which rooms are already assigned

Roommates

- Roommates are defined as 2 individuals in a suite who share a bathroom.
- Alumni/Jacobs roommates share a single room
- Roommates who are committing to live together can both attend Room Selection at time of the roommate with the highest priority number
 - NOTE: This rule **DOES NOT** apply to suitemates.

Proxy Form

- If you can't attend room selection, you may send someone in your place. This person is called a proxy. The proxy can only pull in one person, so you may have to go at 2 separate times.
- Fill out the Proxy form available on the OURES website.
- Give your completed Proxy form AND room selection email to your proxy, and they may select a room for you at your designated time. You will need to have some form of photo ID from the person. (Their petrel pass, license, etc.)
- Roommates may serve as proxies, but still must have the forms mentioned above.

Gender Neutral Housing

- OU offers gender neutral housing
- On your housing app, you may indicate whether or not you are open to living in a mixed gender suite
- Students who choose to live in mixed gender suites must sign a contract

Special Considerations/ Accommodations

- Please share any special considerations/ accommodation request with OURES by Friday, March 27.
- If you have a disability services concern, you will be required to work with the Academic Success Center to learn about options/ services.
